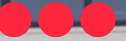

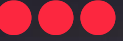

Location & Modus Operandi

With a methodical technical approach, carried out by **determined, experienced and sometimes armed individuals**, convoy attacks are most of the time perfectly programmed.

With a modus operandi that tolerates no unknowns or uncertainties, cargo thefts have multiple consequences:

- ① Loss / Replacement of goods
- ① Human trauma
- ① Damage to corporate reputation

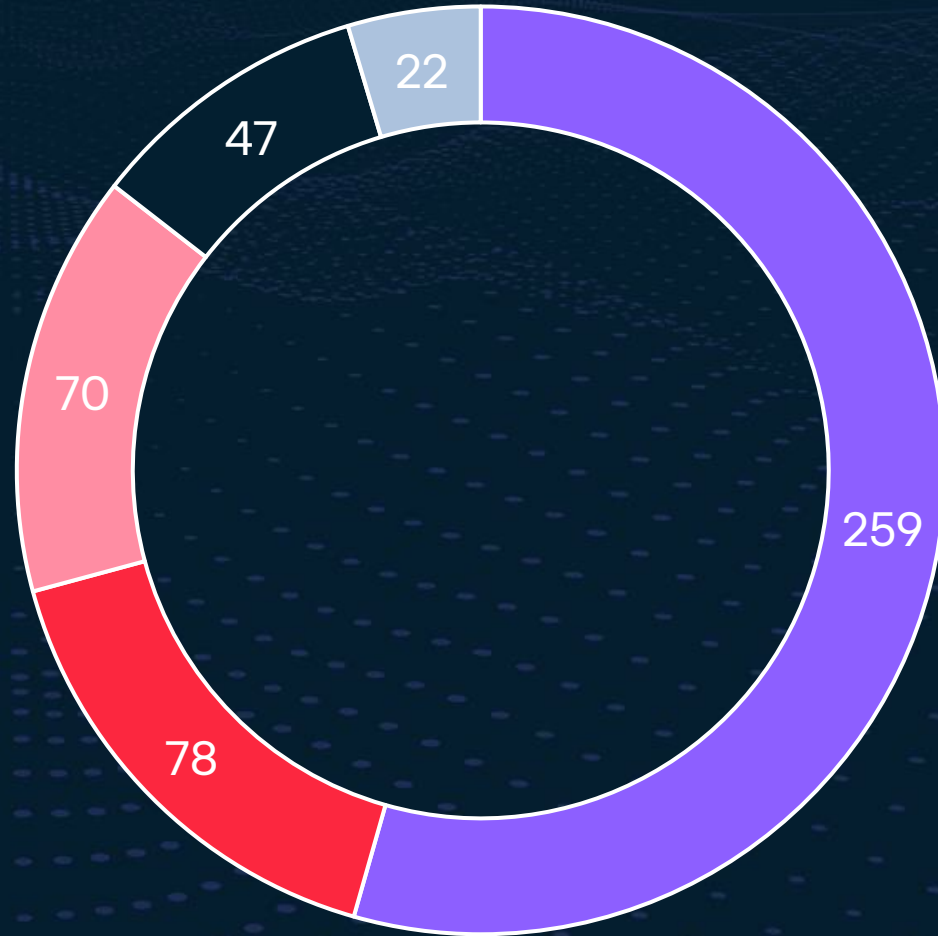

Percentage of incidents in unclassified parking

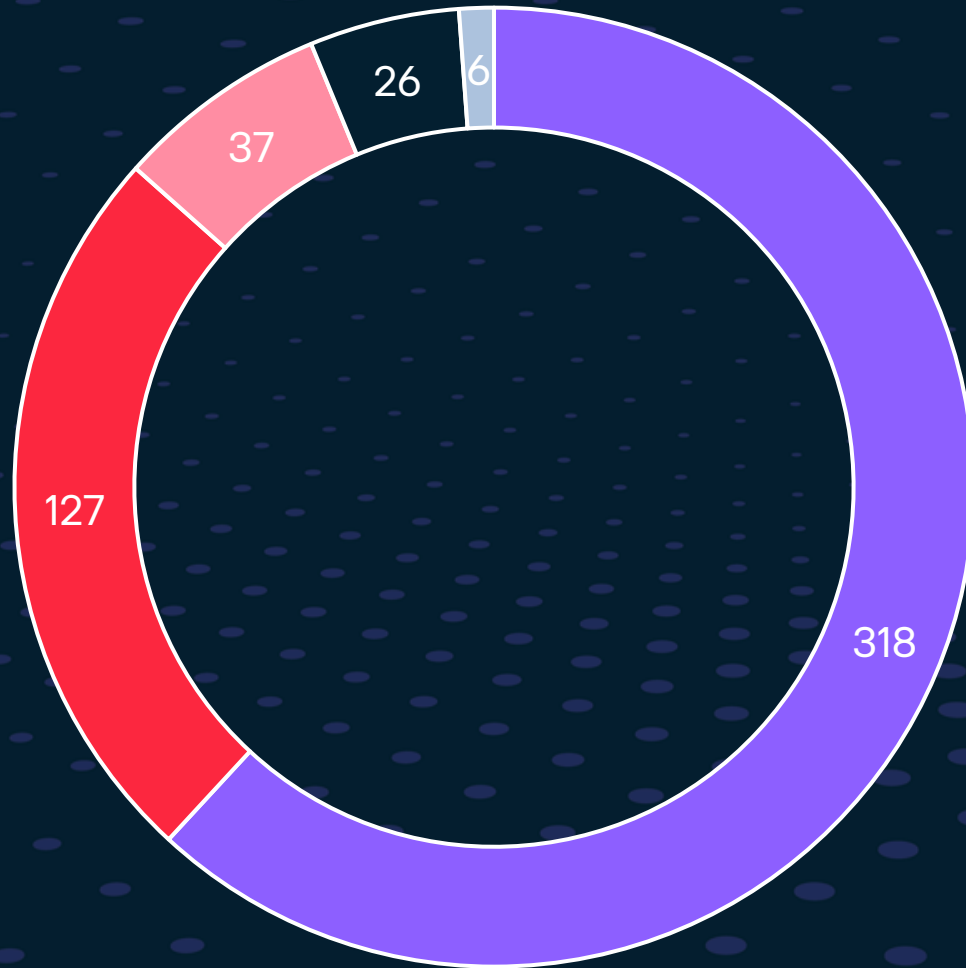
